2018 Tennessee Arts Academy Scholarship Application:

This scholarship is provided by Theatrical Rights Worldwide (TRW) and will be awarded to two theatre arts teachers to attend the 2018 Tennessee Arts Academy at Belmont University campus in Nashville, TN. The scholarship includes full tuition, on-campus double occupancy housing (if needed), and travel stipend towards transportation to/from the conference.

Criteria for the scholarship stipulate that the applicant:

- Must be a Theatre Arts teacher and/or Theatre Director in a public, private or charter school (K-12th).
- Must confirm you plan to teach theatre in a public, private or charter school (K-12th) setting the year commencing the Academy.
- Must submit a letter of recommendation from the applicant's principal, supervisor or other teaching associate.
- Must submit a 100-word essay describing how attending the Academy will benefit your musical theatre program at your school.
- May submit awards and/or honors received to date.

The eligibility period of the scholarship admission shall be until March 1st. A committee will choose the recipients and will base their decision on the scholarship application materials, merit, and need. The scholarship will be awarded no later than April 1st.
